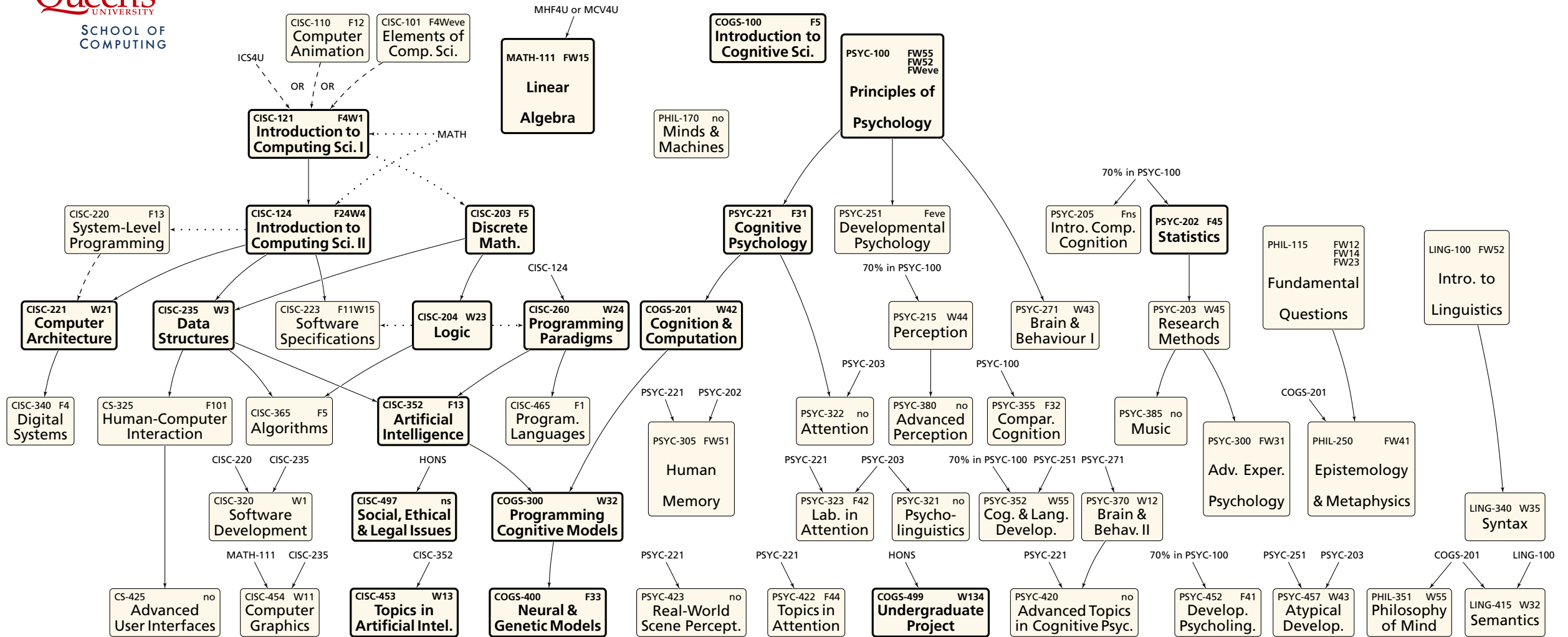


COGNITIVE SCIENCE (BCMPH SSP COGS) 2010-11
